I. Call To Order: The meeting was called to order by President Keith Frank at 5:02 pm.

III. Old Business

A. Theater advertising with J.D. Hock - Stacy stated that the cost for advertising at the Family Theater with J.D. Hock would cost as follows:

\$150 a month at Tawas Theater

\$150 a month at West Branch Theater

\$80 at Oscoda Theater

These costs would be broken down into two weeks intervals. It would be done two weeks prior to auditions and two weeks prior to a show. In order to try it for this year it would be \$450 for our three shows. We would advertise Disaster, Auditions for Always a Bridesmaid, the show dates for Bridesmaid and auditions for Run For Your Wife, and the show Run For Your Wife. This would add up to the three months worth of advertising.

Jolene motioned to advertise at the Tawas Family Theater for 2 weeks prior to Disaster, 2 weeks before auditions for Bridesmaid, 2 weeks prior to Bridesmaid and include audition dates for Run for your Wife, and finally 2 weeks prior to Run for Your Wife. Stacy seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Stacy and Jolene will do this project. Our ads will be a combination of images and short videos.

B. Disaster!: Possible hold over for a third weekend. It could be done on Friday and Saturday the following week. If we do Sunday, it would cost 2 extra weeks of royalties.
