PRE-SHOW

Tasks could begin a month or more ahead and be done well before the show starts, or begin then and continue up to opening night and beyond! **ASK!**

Publicity, biographies, photography, lobby board, props, set design, set construction, set painting, costumes, sound design, set dressing, light design

SHOW TIME

Minimum involvement is the week before and 2 weekends of the show.

Operate sound board, operate lights, usher, organize refreshments, make refreshments, stage manager, stage hand, house manager, hair and/or make-up

POST SHOW

After the last performance help for a couple hours; usually a Sunday afternoon 4:30ish (Summer 9:00ish)

Tear Down Set Take set apart. Put pieces away in scene shop, take props & costumes to proper storage area

Clean Up Stage, dressing room, theater, etc. The show cast and crew help, but more serious cleaning may be needed such as mopping floors, vacuuming the lobby etc.
